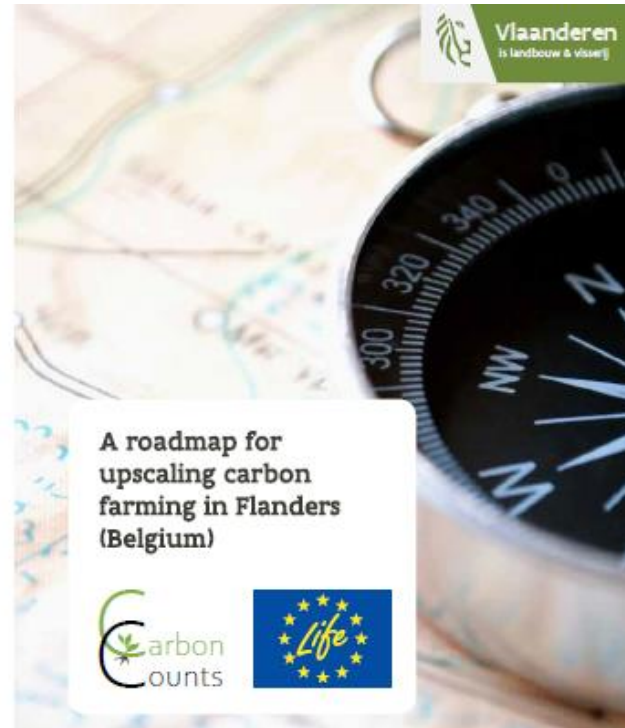

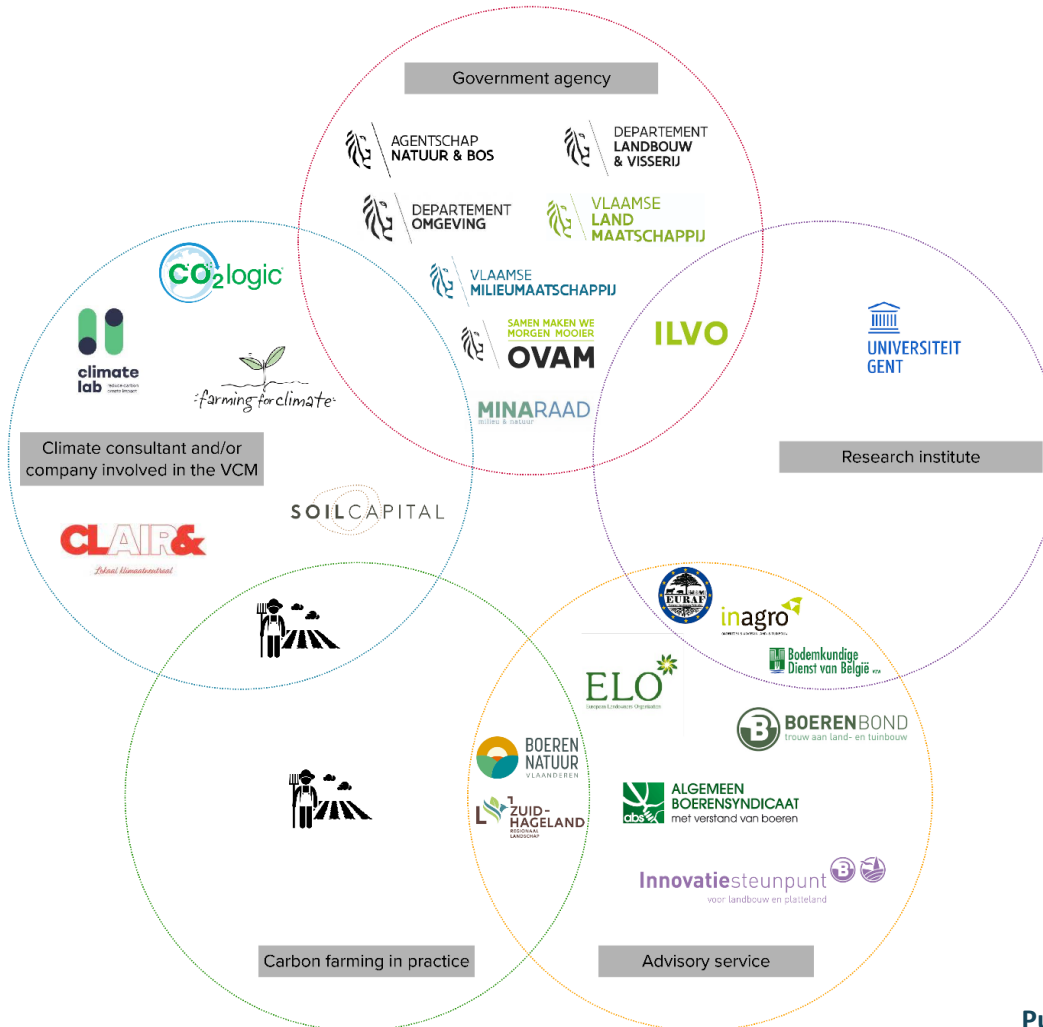

- In depth analysis of pilot schemes



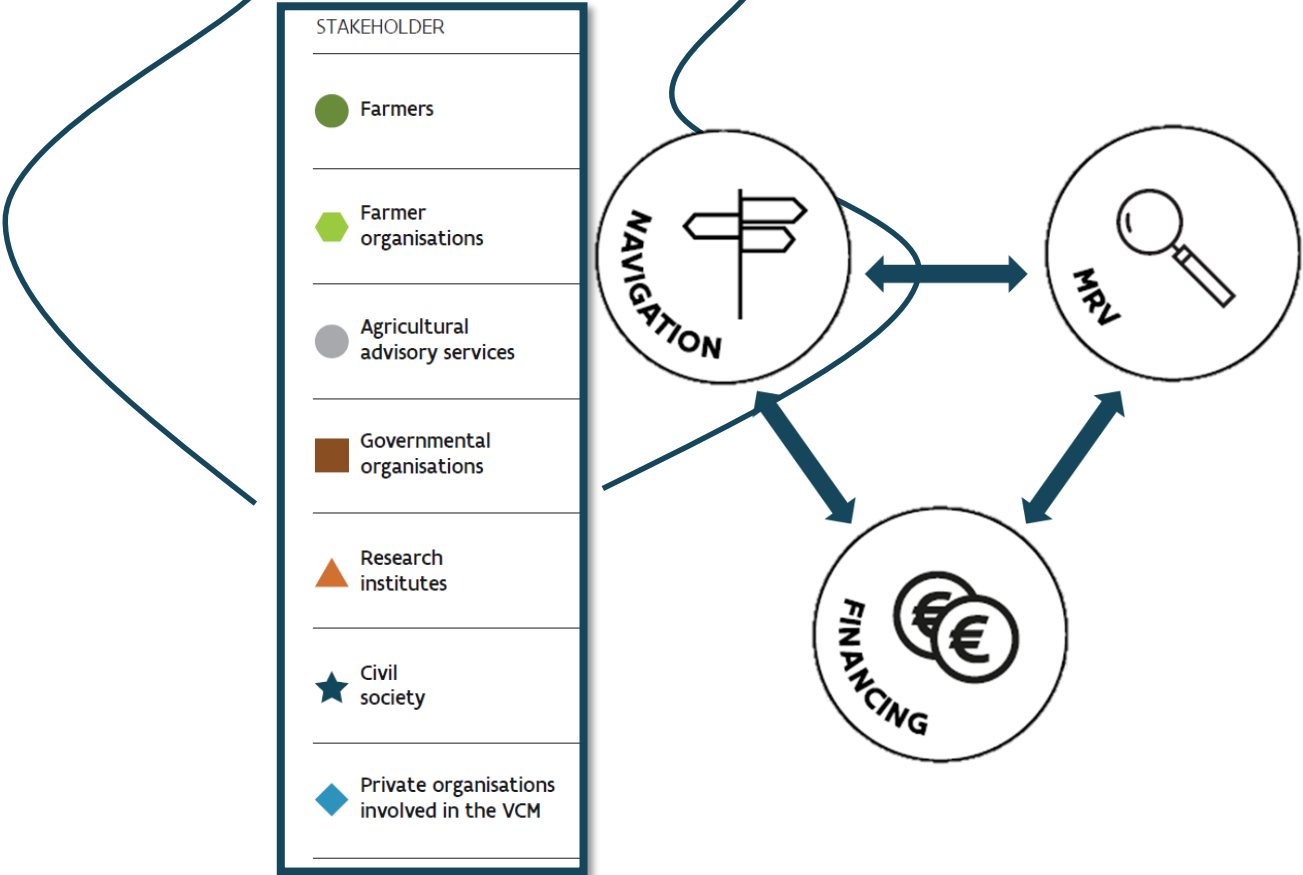

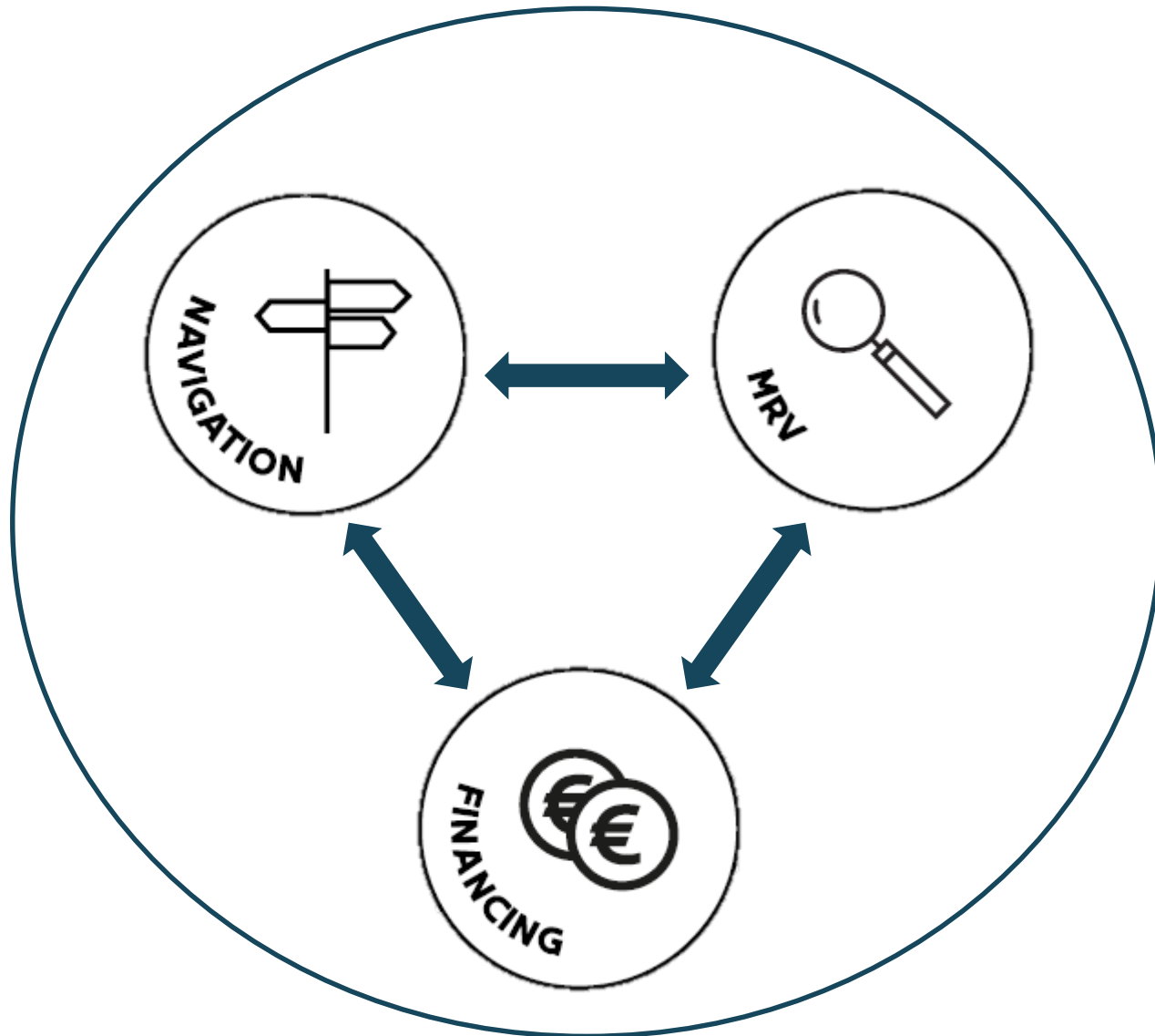

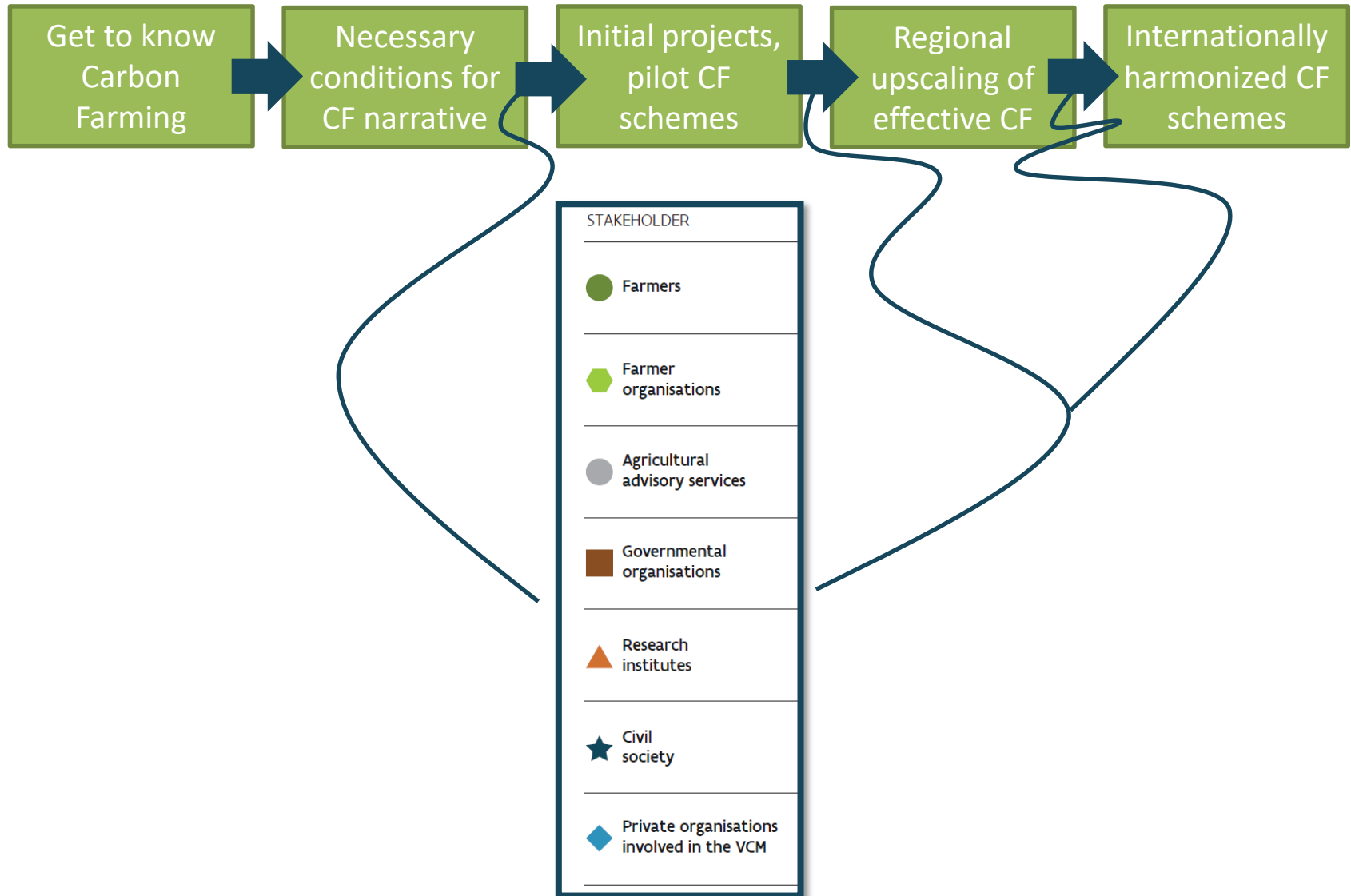
