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Introduction

Scientists wishing to present a poster are invited to return a 1-page abstract **before June 15, 2021** by using the registration page on www.bsfm.be.

Abstracts must be in English. File type must be .docx or .doc.

Please follow the style guidelines described below to make sure your abstract can be published in the Book of Abstracts after it has been accepted by the scientific committee. No figures or tables will be allowed.

Materials and Methods

Margins must be (4x2,5cm). The title should be two lines maximum. Use an asterisk in superscript to indicate the person who will be presenting the paper. The abstract should contain the following sections: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Discussion and References. These subtitles must be used in the text.

Discussion

Please give the file the name of the corresponding author.

The authors should indicate their preference as to the presentation mode (oral or poster).

References
